

C15orf27 polyclonal antibody

BackGround:

Transmembrane protein 266: Voltage-sensor protein present on the post-synaptic side of glutamatergic mossy fibers and granule cells in the cerebellum. Despite the presence of a voltage-sensor segment, does not form a functional ion channel and its precise role remains unclear. Undergoes both rapid and slow structural rearrangements in response to changes in voltage. Contains a zinc-binding site that can regulate the slow conformational transition.

Product:

1mg/ml in 0.42% Potassium phosphate, 0.87% Sodium chloride, pH 7.3, 30% glycerol, and 0.01% sodium azide.

The antibody was purified by immunogen affinity chromatography.

Storage&Stability:

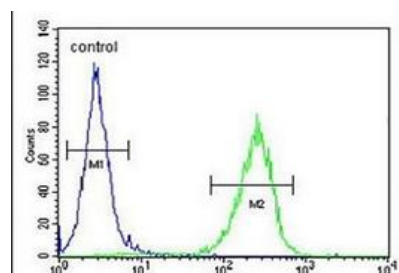
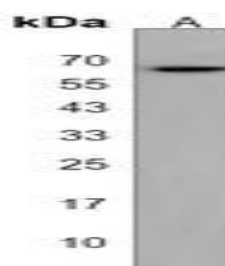
Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long
