BackGround:

Cilia- and flagella-associated protein 69: Cilium- and flagellum-associated protein. In the olfactory epithelium, regulates the speed of activation and termination of the odor response and thus contributes to the robustness of olfactory transduction pathways (By similarity). Required for sperm flagellum assembly and stability

Product:

1mg/ml in 0.42% Potassium phosphate, 0.87% Sodium chloride, pH 7.3, 30% glycerol, and 0.01% sodium azide.

Purification&Purity:

The antibody was purified by immunogen affinity chromatography.

WB (1/500 - 1/1000), IHC (1/50 - 1/200)

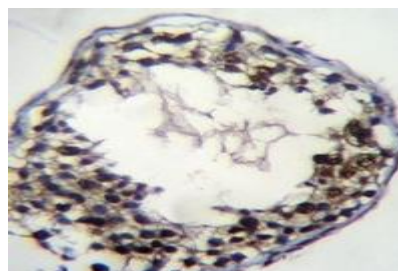
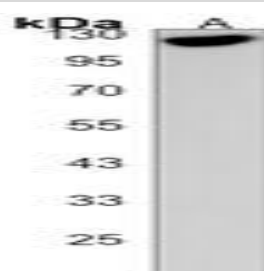
Storage&Stability:
