WB (1/500 - 1/1000), FC (1/10 - 1/50)

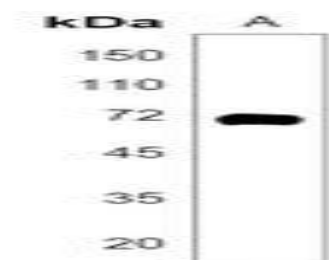
Storage&Stability:

Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

Specificity:

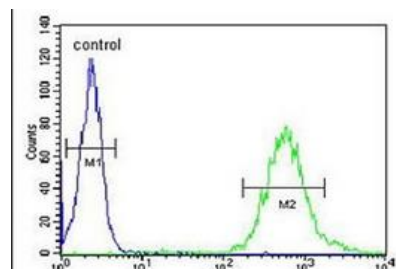
Recognizes endogenous levels of WDTC1 protein.

Western blot analysis of Catalase expression in mouse heart (A), rat heart (B), K562 (C), Hela (D) whole cell lysates.

Immunohistochemical analysis of Catalase staining in human breast carcinoma formalin fixed paraffin embedded tissue section. The section was pre-treated using heat mediated antigen retrieval with sodium citrate buffer (pH 6.0). The section was then incubated with the antibody at room temperature and detected using an HRP conjugated compact polymer system. DAB was used as the chromogen. The section was then counterstained with haematoxylin and mounted with DPX.
