

**KIR3DX1 polyclonal antibody**

BackGround:

Putative killer cell immunoglobulin-like receptor-like protein KIR3DX1. This protein plays important roles in cellular processes, and its expression and regulation are of interest in biomedical research.

Product:

1mg/ml in 0.42% Potassium phosphate, 0.87% Sodium chloride, pH 7.3, 30% glycerol, and 0.01% sodium azide.

~38.8 kDa

Purification&Purity:

The antibody was purified by immunogen affinity chromatography.

Applications:

WB (1/500 - 1/1000)

Storage&Stability:

Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

Specificity:

Recognizes endogenous levels of KIR3DX1 protein

DATA:

Western blot analysis of HAPLN1 expression in EC9706 (A), mouse brain (B), rat brain (C) whole cell lysates.

Immunofluorescent analysis of HAPLN1 staining in COS7 cells. Formalin-fixed cells were permeabilized with 0.1% Triton X-100 in TBS for 5-10 minutes and blocked with 3% BSA-PBS for 30 minutes at room temperature. Cells were probed with the primary antibody in 3% BSA-PBS and incubated overnight at 4 °C in a humidified chamber. Cells were washed with PBST and incubated with an AF488-conjugated secondary antibody (green) in PBS at room temperature in the dark. Phalloidin - AF594 was used to stain Actin filaments (red). DAPI was used to stain the cell nuclei (blue).
