**BackGround:**

Endogenous retroviral envelope protein HEMO: Endogenous envelope proteins originate from retroviral envelope proteins, which mediate receptor recognition and membrane fusion during early infection. Endogenous envelope proteins may have kept, lost or modified their original function during evolution

**Product:**

1mg/ml in 0.42% Potassium phosphate, 0.87% Sodium chloride, pH 7.3, 30% glycerol, and 0.01% sodium azide.

**Molecular Weight:**

~63.5 kDa

**Purification&Purity:**

The antibody was purified by immunogen affinity chromatography.

**Applications:**

WB (1/500 - 1/1000)

**Storage&Stability:**

Store at 4 °C short term. Aliquot and store at -20 °C long term. Avoid freeze-thaw cycles.

Recognizes endogenous levels of ERVMER34-1 protein

Western blot analysis of GLUT2 expression in HEK293T (A), rat kidney (B) whole cell lysates.
